

Modern trends in the functioning and development of the pension system in the framework of the new economic course

Abstract

Subject/topic. The article deals with one of the most discussed today problems and prospects for the development of the pension system in Russia. **Goals/Objectives** The purpose of the research work is to identify current trends and analysis of the work of this mechanism in terms of its implementation and the planned economic spurt. The paper analyzes the prospects for the development of the pension system for the period 2019-2024. **Methodology.** The article uses a set of research methods: scientific sources, statistical analysis of data on the scientific and technological development of the financial support mechanism of the Pension System of the Russian Federation, methods of statistical analysis and financial calculations. **Conclusions/Relevance.** The conclusions are formulated on the system of steps necessary in the conditions of the ongoing pension reform to preserve the stability of the pension system in the Russian Federation.
